Making Connections

Chautauqua CARES offers Service Navigation and Referral Services to individuals currently engaged in the Criminal Justice System or high risk of engagement.

Individuals referred are connected with services and receive Peer Support and Case Management Services for up to 90 days to ensure a warm hand off had occurred.

There is no cost for the services and Chautauqua CARES works with anyone needing to be connected with services.

Chautauqua CARES Support

Individuals referred to Chautauqua CARES receive peer support and case management for up to 90 days to assist referred individuals with connecting with local providers.

Chautauqua CARES Peers follow up with referred individuals on a regular basis to ensure that they have made the proper connections and encourage the individual's participation in treatment.

Referrals that are submitted are triaged within 48 hrs. of being received and are assigned to a CARES Peer whom begins assessing the current needs and coordinating with community providers and supports.
